PARENT AGREEMENT 2010 – 2011

MISSION STATEMENT

Our Lady of the Holy Rosary School is a Catholic educational community that commits itself to fulfill the spiritual, moral, academic, and physical needs of each child.

PHILOSOPHY:

In order to fulfill this mission statement, Our Lady of the Holy Rosary provides a caring environment that nurtures Christian values by having the Eucharist as the center of our lives.

Parents as the primary educators of their children work cooperatively with teachers and staff to build strong and responsible citizens. Our daily instructions provide Our Lady of the Holy Rosary students with the opportunity to acknowledge their self worth and value physically and intellectually.

INTRODUCTION

We the faculty and staff of Our Lady of the Holy Rosary School, welcome you and your family to our school community. You will find that each of us is firmly committed to the formation of a school community which will provide a Christian education for your child/ren.

Since belonging to our school community demands the commitment and dedication of the faculty and staff to the Mission, Philosophy and goals of the school, is likewise necessary for each parent to know, accept and support the effort of the administration to implement and achieve them.

Similarly, it is necessary for you, as the primary educators of your children, to understand fully your part in the formation of the school community. We ask you, therefore, to read the following Agreement and to sign it as an indication of your obligation to the school community.

AGREEMENT

1. We understand that Our Lady of the Holy Rosary is a Catholic, parochial school under the jurisdiction of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. We accept, therefore, that
 - a) The pastor of the parish community is the ex-officio chief administrative officer of the school who carries out the policies of the Archdiocese Advisor Board and, on points not covered by Archdiocese policy, determines policies appropriate to the needs of the school.
 - b) The principal is responsible for the immediate direction and supervision of the school program.
2. We understand that certain responsibilities require our continuous support if the school is to achieve its goals. We agree, therefore,
 - a) To participate in the Religion, Family Life and Aids Education program and related activities such as weekly attendance at Sunday Eucharist and frequent reception of the Sacraments, in order to make teaching of religion a reality in the life of our child/ren.
 - b) To encourage our child/ren to learn by providing a home environment suitable for study.

- c) To abide by the decision of the principal regarding grade placement and advancement or retention of our child/ren.
- d) To abide by all school and Archdiocese regulations and policies and to accept all disciplinary actions, including withdraw of our child/ren, for non-compliance with these regulations and policies.
- e) To complete and return all forms and records necessary to comply with school, Archdiocese or state regulations in a timely manner.
- f) To attend at least (4) P T O meetings and attend a Parent/Teacher Conference to pick up the child/ren Report Card.

3. We understand that tuition and fees cover only a part of the total cost of educating our children. We agree therefore,

- a) To support the school through regular tuition payments and fees.
- b) To make a minimum contribution of \$ 8.00 per week using the Sunday envelope over 52 week period, one (1) calendar year (Jan. – Dec.) prior to school registration. Otherwise, you will not qualify for the contributing parishioners' rate.
- c) To assist in making up the deficit by assuming a share of the duties to fund raising such as, Book Fairs, Walk-a-ton, Raffles, and other activities assigned by the principal.
- d) To participate and/or pay the fee of the mandatory events such as Chocolate Drives, Valentine's Dance, Family Day, Talent Show, and other events promoted by the P.T.O. Board.

SERVICE HOURS AND SCRIP

Each school family is required to perform 45 hours of volunteer work for the school each year or pay an additional \$360.00 (\$8.00 per hour). These service hours help defray the costs and also provide an opportunity to take pride in and ownership of our school, feeling a sense of pride in providing services for our children. Parents are given the opportunity to choose those areas in which they could serve. Each family is required to purchase \$750.00 worth of scrip, \$300.00 or pay a 20% of this amount.

We also understand that to qualify for Contributing Parishioners Tuition Rate we need to contribute no less than \$ 416.00 (\$8.00 per 52 weeks) per one calendar year (Jan.-Dec.) prior to school registration and each year following.

If your child qualifies for scholarship, that amount will be deducted from the non-parishioner rate.

TUITION POLICY

Tuition payments will be made to FACTS Tuition Management Services by Automatic Check Deduction beginning in August 2010 and ending in May 2011. A \$ 25.00 late fee will be added to the monthly rate for each delinquent payment

I understand that I will need to pay a \$45.00 fee for any changes on the FACTS status after the registration.
